



ELECTRICITY UNIT FAULTSMAN

Total Remuneration Package R256 194, 00/320 457, 00 pa Grade 11

Duties Include: Together with one Faults man Assistant, provide an emergency service to restore electricity supply to customers after it has failed, to give immediate attention to rectifying unsafe conditions and to assist with other work, as per duty schedule.

Note: This position is subject to the working of a 40 hour week, 5 days out of 7 days as per shift roster

Qualifications (Essential): Must be a qualified electrician who has served an apprenticeship recognised by The Department of Labour. In possession of a NTC2 or NCV3 in electrical engineering from a Further Education and Training College registered with the Department of Education. Valid code EB or EC1 (10) driver's licence, as applicable, or be able to obtain one within 6 months of the date of appointment. Professional Driving Permit (PrDP) or obtain one within 6 months of the date of appointment, if required. Must be trained in First Aid or be trained within 6 months of the date of appointment. Must be an "Authorised Person" in terms of the Safety Rules and System Operating Regulations, or be in a position to obtain same within six months of appointment. (Preferred): Same as above

Experience (Essential): Min 2 year's experience in the installation and maintenance of all types of equipment found on a distribution network. **(Preferred):** Min 3 year's experience with, and a thorough knowledge of eThekweni Electricity's Distribution system and technical practices. Deemed competent for overhead mains construction and maintenance up to and including 11kV. Deemed competent for underground mains construction and maintenance up to and including 11kV. Deemed competent to carry out the duties of a Faults Technician.

Successful applicants will be required to undergo and pass a mandatory pre-employment medical assessment to determine fitness to perform the duties of the post
