The Incubation Programme facility is situated at 31 Harry Gwala Street (former 240 Booth Road) in Cator Manor, at the Umkhumbane Entrepreneurial Support Centre (UESC). Purpose of the programme

The incubation programme is aimed at growing the emerging businesses to sustainable manufacturing businesses competent in the broader economy. Support and services that will be offered to selected candidates are:

- Incubation Infrastructure

and 24 hour security

- Training and conference facilities (floor space)
- Subsidised rental
- Business development programme (training, mentorship and coaching)
- Facilitate access to finance and markets

For the business to be considered they must meet the following requirements:

- Must be in full operation for at least 36 months
- Must have a track record of profitability
- Manufacturer non-toxic products

All interested businesses are required to submit:

- Marketable business plans
- Business financial records checked by an accountant/ stamped 3 months bank statement

- Tax clearance certificate
- CK document

The above documents should be accompanied by an application form obtainable from the BSTMU offices. Failure to submit any of the above documents will lead to disqualification.

On selection you will be requested to attend a compulsory evaluation interview. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted. Deadline for application forms submission is 7 January 2012, at 16:00.
